



Dodecahedron Star Template

1. Transfer star-shape (including dark grey flaps) to a sheet of colorful paper. (I recommend using a heavy-duty needle to pierce the template at each intersection of lines. The corresponding pattern will be transferred to a sheet of paper placed beneath this template.) Cut 12 star shapes for this piece.
2. With your pattern transferred, use a straight edge and a craft knife to cut out your star shape. You will need 12 such star shapes to complete this project. Precision matters in this project so cut carefully.
3. Use a bone creaser and a straight edge to score all five tabs before folding them.
4. Assemble stars by slotting the point of one star to the point of another. Flaps should be glued to the inside edge of adjoining stars.

Tip: Assembling these items takes patience. Go slowly. Handle gently. I suggest slotting together five or six stars before beginning to glue them.
